Curriculum:

To achieve the objectives, a comprehensive curriculum has been designed under the supervision of highly educated experts. The design of this curriculum has been set keeping in view the learning and interest process of students. Pre-school Montessori and Kindergarten curriculum has been prepared in a systematic way to mould minds of students at this age in a balanced way. Character building of students is our main focus.

- To mentor the students on an intellectual, physical, emotional and social platform, keeping in mind their growth and personal capability.
- To set educational goals for children for their spiritual and social growth.
- To provide freedom, opportunities, encouragement and mentoring to students in such a way that they attain self confidence and discipline while respecting elders.
- To provide Islamic education and mentoring through practical exercises.
- To give Special attention from early ages of students using age appropriate syllabus of Articles of Faith, Fiqh, Ethics & Manners, Seerat-ul-Nabi (ﷺ), Masnoon Dua'ain & History.
- During primary education, goals will be achieved from prevalent, modern, quality books and courses in which photos and un-Islamic contents will be censored.
- The purpose of Islamic education for primary students will be to provide them mandatory Islamic knowledge in order to make them knowledgeable and practicing in **Farz** (obligatory), **Wajib** (necessary), **Mustahab/Sunnah** (recommended) & **Mubah** (permissible)duties.

The Mentoring system of students will be formed according to Islamic values and associated attributes will be highlighted. With the collaboration of parents, strategies will be formed for mentoring and supervision, checking and balancing and reforming of students and the whole mentoring process will be examined so that each student can be monitored according to the goals set. Parents and teachers continue to review and change goals as required during the mentoring and grooming process. The goal of the senior school system is to groom the students as confident and strong personalities and produce practical Muslims who do possess the expertise of international standards.

A'Level with Awala Sanwiah:

A blend of Islamic and modern education is one of the aims and objectives of Hira Foundation School. Keeping this in view, school administration has started the A Level programalong with Dars-e-Nizami in which students will be eligible to appear for **Darja Sanwiah Wifaaq** examinations. Experienced staff have been hired for this specific purpose.

Current Grades:

Hira Foundation School has categorized the Preschool section into three grades; Junior Montessori, Senior Level One & Senior Level Two.

Primary and secondary sections are classified into Grade I, II, III, IV, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX & Hifz. The O Level and A Level sections engage students from grade 9 to 11, and As and A levels respectively.

Date of Registration:

Registrations in Hira Foundation School will begin from 15th December, 2021.

Procedure of Registration:

Parents may obtain the Registration Form from the school office, and fill up the required information correctly. Registration will be completed only after submission of the registration form with attached required documents in the school office. Registration will be considered incomplete if required documents are not provided. Parents will be informed about the admission test date of the student after registration.

After the successful admission test, interview datefor the parents will be given. Names of successful students will be displayed on the school notice board. Admission will be marked final only after receiving the deposit of fee within the due date. In case of delay, the admission may be cancelled. Admission tests of Junior Montessori will be based on talent and the capability of the student.

If there is vacancy in other grades then admission test of students will be conducted in English, Urdu, Math, Arabic and Qura'an according to the grade level. As every grade has fixed and limited number of seats, only the best students will be selected.



Online Registrations

Hira Foundation School is also accepting registrations online. Once the details are filled you may proceed with your online payment via PayPro to register your child with the school for the admissions for the upcoming session.

Required Documents for Registration:

Following documents are mandatory to be attached with registration form.

- 1. Attested photocopy of student's birth certificate/ Form B.
- 2. Attested photocopy of CNIC of Mother & Father.
- 3. Four photographs of student (1" X 1").
- 4. Photocopy of registration fee slip.
- 5. Last result report card.
- 6. Vaccination card required for Preschool.

Note: Please be informed that admission in primary and secondary classes will be done on mearit basis.

Transport:

The school does not have its own transport. Keeping in view the convenience of parents, school administration is already in contact with wewell-reputedransport agencies that provide pick and drop services for students. Transportation fee will be set after mutual consultation of parents and transport agencies. Contact number of transport agencies can be taken from the school office.
